ITINERARY JUNE 20 - 30, 2023

DAY 1 JUNE 20	Depart U.S.
DAY 2 JUNE 21	Arrive in Lisbon, visit local churches including the Church of St. Anthony. Opening Mass and dinner at a local restaurant.
DAY 3 JUNE 22	Depart for Santarem, a Eucharistic Miracle site, and celebrate Mass. Visit the monastery of Batahla before departing to Fatima for the candlelight rosary procession.
DAY 4 JUNE 23	Spend the day in Fatima, with Mass at the shrine and an afternoon exploring the grounds and village, with time for personal prayer and devotion.
DAY 5 JUNE 24	Depart for Spain. Visit Alba de Tormes to pray and celebrate Mass at St. Teresa of Avila's tomb. Continue to Avila and explore the city.
DAY 6 JUNE 25	Visit the beautiful sites of Avila, like the Cathedral and convent. In the afternoon, pray within the penitential cave of St. Dominic and celebrate Mass.
DAY 7 JUNE 26	Visit the historical city of Zaragoza. Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, and enjoy wine tasting at a local winery.
DAY 8 JUNE 27	Visit the Sanctuary of Torreciudad and pray in the church built by St. Josemaria Escriva. Celebrate Mass at the Sanctuary, and journey on to Lourdes.
DAY 9 JUNE 28	Enjoy a full day exploring the Lourdes shrine and St. Bernadette's home. Celebrate Mass, and enjoy an afternoon of prayer, private devotion, and shopping.
DAY 10 JUNE 29	Enjoy a free day with time for private devotions visiting the baths, walking the life-size Stations of the Cross, or praying at the Grotto. Close out your pilgrimage with a Vigil Mass and Farewell Dinner.
